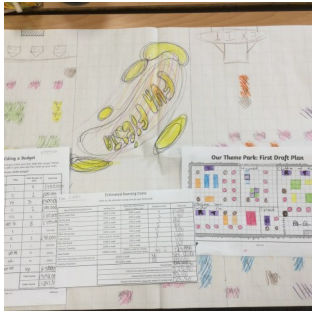

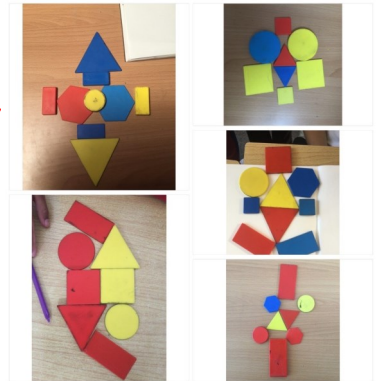


Year 3

In DT this term, Year 3 have started using hacksaws and hot glue guns to practice before making their own greenhouses!

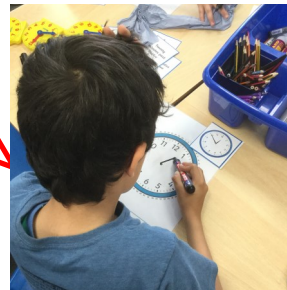
Year 4

In Footsteps for Literacy our story is All aboard the London bus. On our bus, we visited Buckingham Palace and saw the changing of the guards!



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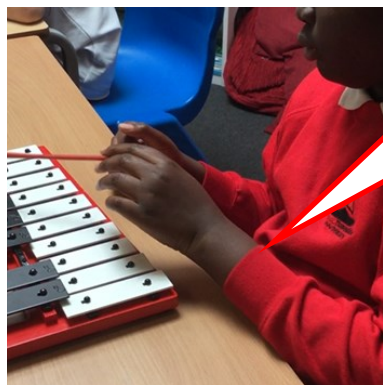
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Year 1
